Students will only be registered for testing if the consent form was completed online. Please can students ensure that they arrive at the start of their time slot.

Remote work will be set for students who are not in school from Monday 6<sup>th</sup> September until their full return later that week. If a student is in school for testing they will not be expected to complete work for that lesson.

Public Health England have asked us to remind parents and students that getting the vaccine is the single most important step we can take to protect ourselves, our families and our communities against COVID-19. The vaccine has been tested by scientists and researchers worldwide and every vaccine has gone through thorough checks for safety and effectiveness.

As of Monday 23rd August, just over 6,500 people aged under 18 in Bedfordshire, Luton and Milton Keynes have been vaccinated. However more than 18,000 are yet to receive their jab. Even if students have had the virus, the vaccine will provide additional

protection for them, their families and school staff. Attached to this letter is information on how to find your local vaccine centre.
